General Description

Saint-Emilion is the oldest wine area of the Bordeaux region. The UNESCO organization recognized the great terroir of Saint Emilion and put the site on the World Heritage List .

Saint Emilion wines are considered the most robust of the Bordeaux. They are generous, very colored, and reach their maturity quicker than other red Bordeaux.

Château Lagrange Monbadon, property of Countess Bertrand de Sercey, can be found at Monbadon-Puisseguin, 40 kilometers from Bordeaux.

Wine Tasting Notes

Colourful wine with softness and flavor.

The colour is a solid, mid-tone ruby.

The nose has cedary fruit and soft notes of summer berries. There's reasonable depth and richness to the fruit and wood balance underpinned by decent tannins and low-acidity. Really rather a nice and classy wine for not a lot of money. This wine will age in five years and will be perfect with starters and white meats.

Specifics

Grape Varieties: Merlot 60 %, Cabernet Sauvignon 40 %

Average vine age 25 years.

The grapes are picked-out on a double table in order to ensure a better quality.

This wine benefits from thermoregulation by heat-exchange.

The wine-making of our parcels separately includes a cold pre fermentation maceration of 4 to 5 days and a post fermentation maceration of 15 to 20 days depending on the vintage and the grape variety.
