



CHATEAU LANGOIRAN

Bordeaux Rosé

Between Langon and Bordeaux, on the right side of the Garonne River, Château Langoiran is located in the enclosure of the Medieval Castle of XIIIth century which overhangs the small town of LANGOIRAN. The 22 hectares of vines are all located on well exposed hills which are just behind the Fortress

<i>Appellation :</i>	AOC Bordeaux Rosé
<i>Area :</i>	2 Hectares
<i>Yields :</i>	49 Hl/Ha
<i>Grape Varieties :</i>	Mainly Cabernet Franc
<i>Subsoil :</i>	Limestone
<i>Soils :</i>	Very gravelly soil with clay areas
<i>Vinification :</i>	"Rosé de Saignée" : short maceration (few hours), 10 to 15% of the juice is taken away and put in a stainless thermo-regulated tank at 4°C (cold decanting) then fermentation at 18°C.
<i>Production :</i>	9000 bottles

Tasting Comments

<i>Robe :</i>	Clear raspberry
<i>Nose :</i>	Refreshing fruity aromas
<i>Mouth :</i>	Very fruity taste (strawberry, raspberry, red current), this rosé is also floral (rose). Good balance between Alcohol and Acids

Elaborated with the "Rosé de Saignée" way, this wine is coming from young cabernet vines.
Summer wine to drink with salads, barbecue, or just as an refreshing aperitif.
Very pleasant wine to appreciate at 7-8°C.
