

# *Châteauneuf du Pape*

## *Domaine Bouvachon Nomine Red*

*Region: Rhone Valley*

*Appellation: AOC Châteauneuf du Pape*



### *General Description*

The estate is situated on the commune of Orange, on the way to Châteauneuf du Pape.

The vineyard is situated close to the village and extends on about 8 acres. The subsoil is clayey-chalky, covered with rolled pebbles gathered naturally at the ice age.

Most of the vines are old (1922 and 1939). The yield is limited to produce the most prestigious wine of Rhone Valley.

### *Wine Tasting Notes*

Wonderful appearance displaying a bright crimson robe.

The nose reveals spicy aromas, cocoa, vanilla and ripe fruit in the finish.

Very beautiful and deep mouth with touches of black and red fruits, leather and wood. Rather long and spicy finish.

A wine to be enjoyed now, it will reach full maturity within eight to ten years.

For those who have a taste for grilled red meat, serve this wine with a Chateaubriand sauce béarnaise.

### *Specifics*

Grape Varieties: 60% Grenache, 30 % Mourvèdre, 10 % Cinsaut

Alcohol content: 13.5%

Manual harvest then destemming of the grapes

Maceration and fermentation are made in stainless-steel tanks under control of the temperature

Maturing in tanks for 18 months before bottling

Estate bottled
