### ***General Description***

Everything started with Pauline, the great grandmother of Eric, who from 1860 sold her wines on markets. "Les Celliers de la Pauline" are named after her so as our special cuvée called "Cuvée de Pauline" in our honor.

In the 70's the fame of Sancerre wines begins to expand in France and even across our borders. This is when the Domain really get started thanks to the work of Léon Louis, Eric's father.

Settled on the land of Thauvenay for several generations, the Louis family has always worked these generous soils. Heir of a strong tradition of quality, Eric now relies on modern production implements to create a wine typical from its appellation and nonetheless very personal...Result of know-how attentive to the needs of nature and the demands of the cellar.

Nearby the "Celliers de la Pauline" stands the cellar of the "Domaine Curot" runned by Eric's sister with the help of his brother. The domain spreads over 23 acres.

### ***Wine Tasting Notes***

Powerful nose, fruity and concentrated. Good attack on the mouth with the aroma of fresh fruit and citrus. The final is long and aromatic.

At Domaine Curot every ounce of fruit flavour was squeezed from select parcels of super ripe Sauvignon Blanc, gathered from an exceptional vintage. Powerful gooseberry and melon flavours are balanced with a zip of fish-dish friendly citrus fruit.
