

# *Cuvee De La Patrasse*

## *Domaine Bouvachon Nomine Red*

*Region: Rhone Valley*

*Appellation: AOC Cotes du Rhone Villages*



### *General Description*

The estate is situated on the commune of Orange, on the way to Châteauneuf du Pape, it consists in about 55 acres, 48 of which in one block classified in Côtes du Rhône and Côtes du Rhône Villages around the winery.

The clayey-chalky subsoil is covered with a light soil for the vineyard of Côtes du Rhône and with rolled pebbles for the vineyard of Côtes du Rhône Villages.

### *Wine Tasting Notes*

Dusky red in colour.

Nice and fresh on the nose marked by intense red fruits.

Beautiful and deep mouth with blackberries and some presence of strawberries. Well rounded with long finish.

A wine could be enjoyed now; however it will reach full maturity within three to four years.

Perfect match with lamb with herbs, or grilled pike or bass.

### *Specifics*

Grape Varieties: 33% Grenache very old vines over 50 years, 33% syrah and 33 % mourvèdre

Alcohol content: 13.5%

Manual harvest then destemming of the grapes

Maceration and fermentation are made in stainless-steel tanks under control of the temperature during 15 days

Maturing for 12 months in oak barrels before bottling
