

Domaine Bouvachon Nomine Red

Region: Rhone Valley

Appellation: AOC Cotes du Rhone



General Description

The estate is situated on the commune of Orange, on the way to Châteauneuf du Pape, it consists in about 55 acres, 48 of which in one block classified in Côtes du Rhône and Côtes du Rhône Villages around the winery.

The clayey-chalky subsoil is covered with a light soil for the vineyard of Côtes du Rhône and with rolled pebbles for the vineyard of Côtes du Rhône Villages.

Wine Tasting Notes

Beautiful deep, bright and clear purple robe.

Pleasant, rich and complex nose with aromas of small fresh red fruits. The mouth is pleasant with silky and mellow tannins.

A generous wine endowed with a wide aromatic range of red fruits. A wine to be enjoyed right now, it will reach full maturity within three to five years.

You will enjoy this wine with rabbit sauce chasseur served with mushrooms of the forest, or with delicatessen.

Specifics

Grape Varieties: 50% grenache, 20% mourvèdre, 20% cinsaut, 10% syrah

Alcohol content: 13%

Manual harvest then destemming of the grapes

Maceration and fermentation are made in stainless-steel tanks under control of the temperature during 8 days

Maturing for 4 to 6 months before bottling
