

LA CHATEAU CAILLAVEL Red

Region: Bergerac

General Description

This XVIIIth century castle is situated in the town of Lembras, 6 km from Bergerac. Built on the top of a hill, it dominates the region and offers an unforgettable setting, between vineyards and forests.

The Pécharmant, its appellation contrôlée vineyard, faces south and covers 40 hectares. The ground rich in iron gives to this vin de garde a subtle bouquet, and its incomparable taste makes it one of the finest products of the Dordogne.

This vineyard of 40 hectares in a single plot represents 10 % of the whole production of red wine of the AOC Pécharmant. This wine has been produced in the region since the XVIIIth century

Wine Tasting Notes

Bright ruby colour with shady undertones.

On nose expression of red fruits.

Following a strong attack, the mouth reveals to warm and roundness of tannins with a nice display of black fruits.

This wine suits very well French south western cuisine; especially foie gras, wild mushrooms, preserved meat. Perfect with red meats, game,

It will mature nicely between 5 to 7 years.
